

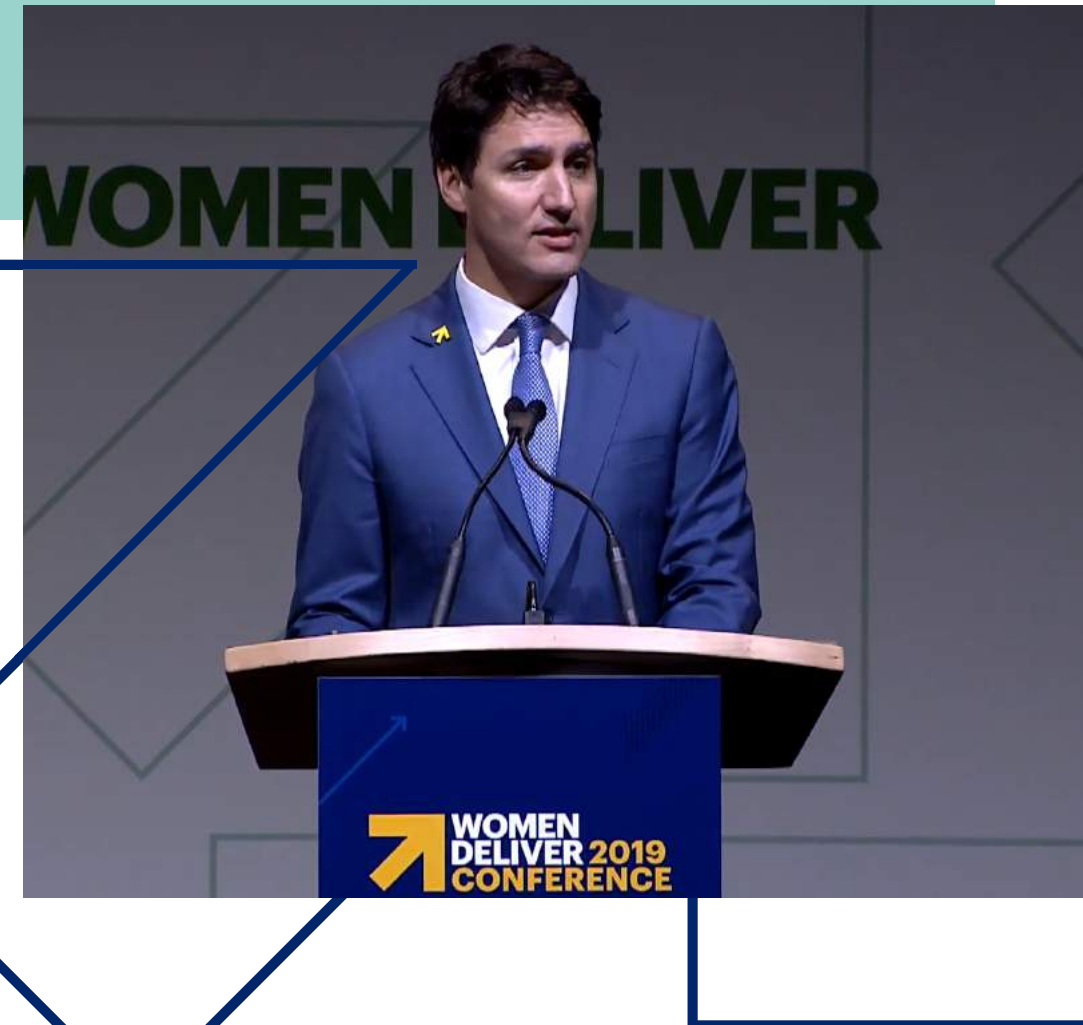

Government of Canada Makes Historic Investment to Promote the Health and Rights of Women and Girls around the World

Prime Minister, Justin Trudeau, made a major announcement on June 4, 2019 at the Women Deliver 2019 Conference that the Government of Canada will raise its funding to reach \$1.4 billion annually, starting in 2023, to support women and girls' health around the world. This ten-year commitment of investment will support sexual and reproductive health rights and maternal, newborn, and child health.
