Brandon was appointed to oversee the relationship between Canada and the U.S. as Consul General of Canada in San Francisco and then also in Seattle and was Canada's Ambassador to Silicon Valley.

Brandon has a strong background both as an executive and leading innovation, and he has held several executive positions with national and international governments.

From 2007 to 2011, he oversaw global reform activities to strengthen Canada's international presence and became the Department's first Director of Innovation.

From 2012 to 2014, Mr. Lee held senior positions at the World Trade Organization and the International Committee of the Red Cross (both in Geneva), spearheading major organizational and international reform initiatives.

Previously, Brandon worked in the private sector as a pioneer entrepreneur in online banking in North America and also with large-scale telecommunications management consulting.
